Firefighter Bunker Gear

The Lindsborg Fire Department set up a plan to purchase three sets of new bunker gear each year to replace bunker gear that is expired, is set to expire during the fiscal year, is unserviceable, or to equip newly appointed firefighters. One set of bunker gear is currently needed to replace one set that is expired, the other two sets of bunker gear are to equip newer firefighters with gear measured for them.

Staff budgeted \$9,000.00 for this fiscal year to purchase three new sets of bunker gear.

Prices were obtained from three different vendors. The three vendors are as follows:

Ed M. Feld Equipment Co. \$2,972.94 x 3 = \$8918.82

All Hands Public Safety \$3,841.98 x 3 = \$11,525.94
Galls \$3,798.40 x 3 = 11,395.20

(Galls Custom Stitching not included)

Councilmember Kirsten Bruce moved to approve the purchase of three sets of bunker gear from Ed M. Feld Equipment Co. in the amount of \$8,918.82. Seconded by Councilmember Joshua Swanson and passed 8-0 by roll call vote.
