ORDINANCE NO. 5591

SUMMARY OF AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 50-542 OF THE CITY CODE OF THE CITY OF LINDSBORG, KANSAS, RELATING TO PERMITTED USES IN THE C-2 RETAIL BUSINESS DISTRICT.

WHEREAS, on May 26th, 2026 the City of Lindsborg passed Ordinance Number 5591, which amends Section 50-542 of the City Code which, amongst other things, updated the City Code relating to permitted uses in the C-2 Retail Business District. In summary, the following uses changed from permitted uses to uses that may be allowed by special use permit upon approval from the board of zoning appeals: automobile parking lots and garages, cigar and tobacco stores, electric substations, telephone exchange and utility regular stations, funeral home and mortuaries, lumberyards, and rental storage units. Occupancy of the first floor residential housing unit is no longer restricted to the owner of the building and owner or manager of the front half commercial business.
