Water Operator II

Lindsborg has a strong sense of community, volunteerism, and numerous small-town amenities which make it a great place to call home. From festivals and arts to recreation programs, walking trails, and much more, there is always something to do in Lindsborg. Lindsborg is conveniently located just off I-135 and only 15 minutes to Salina and McPherson, which provides Lindsborg with the perfect combination of small-town living and large-town convenience.

The City of Lindsborg is now accepting applications for the position of Water Operator II. This position requires a KDHE Class II Water Operators Certificate or the ability to achieve the certificate within six months of the start of employment. The person in this position is responsible for the day-to-day operation and maintenance of the City's wells and water distribution system. The position requires a working knowledge of water distribution systems, operation and maintenance of chlorine systems, repair of water mains, installation of services, and knowledge of wells, pumps, water towers, and electronic controls. The water department collects water samples for testing, maintains the fire hydrant flushing and valve exercise programs, and maintains the swimming pool as well as other duties deemed necessary.

The City of Lindsborg offers a full benefits package including health & dental insurance, KPERs retirement, paid vacation and sick leave, paid holidays, as well as a supplemental AFLAC and Security Benefit 457 retirement plans. A pre-employment drug screen and Level 3 fitness testing will be required. The candidate must possess a high school diploma/GED and a valid Kansas driver's license.
