Public notice is hereby given that the City Council of the City of Lindsborg, Kansas (the "Issuer"), will conduct a public hearing on April 5, 2021 at 6:30 p.m., or as soon thereafter as may be heard at J.O. Sundstrom Conference Center, 102 N. Main Street, Lindsborg, KS 67456 in regard to the issuance by the Issuer of its Industrial Revenue Bonds (Sprout House Learning Center Project), in a principal amount not to exceed \$2,600,000 (the "Bonds"), which are expected to be tax-exempt qualified 501(c)(3) bonds. The Bonds are proposed to be issued by the Issuer under authority of K.S.A. 12-1740 *et seq.*, as amended, to pay the costs of the acquisition, construction, furnishing, and equipping of an approximately 10,000 square foot childcare facility to be located near the northwest corner of the intersection of Wells Fargo Road and Emerald Drive in Lindsborg, Kansas (the "Project"). The Issuer further intends to lease such facility to Sprout House Learning Center Inc., a Kansas not for profit corporation (the "Borrower"). The Borrower will be the manager and operator of the Project. The governing body of the Issuer will not pass an ordinance authorizing the issuance of such revenue bonds until said public hearing has been concluded.

Notice is further given, in accordance with K.S.A. 12-1744e, that the Issuer intends to issue the Bonds and lease the facility to the Borrower as set out above.

A copy of this Notice, together with a copy of the inducement resolution of the Issuer to be considered for adoption on April 5, 2021, indicating the intent of the governing body of the Issuer to issue such Bonds is on file in the office of the Clerk, or will be as soon as completed, and available for public inspection during normal business hours.
