Planning & Zoning – ORDINANCE 5111 – DIGITAL SIGNAGE – Rick Martin moved to adopt Ordinance 5111 which would allow digital signage in certain zoning districts. Motion seconded by David Higbee. After discussion, the roll call vote was 4 yes votes by members Martin, Ed Radatz, Mark Friesen and David Higbee; 2 no votes by members Heble and Nelson; and one abstention by Duncan. DESIGN STANDARDS FOR C-3 COMMERCIAL BUSINESS DISTRICT - A request has been received to consider implementing design standards in the C-3 General Business District. This area is along the Harrison-Cole Corridor. The request is based upon some businesses in the C-3 zoning district changing hands and the likelihood of remodel of the businesses. Currently the only guidelines in the C-3 General Business District are lot coverage, building height, yard setbacks, signage, parking & loading, and landscaping (Regulations attached for reference). To implement design regulations in the C-3 district, it must first be reviewed and recommended by the Planning & Zoning (P&Z) Commission. The changes proposed by would then be forwarded to City Council in the form of an ordinance. The ordinance would then be adopted by City Council and 21 days after the ordinance is adopted it would become effective. This will be forwarded to the Planning and Zoning Commission.
